Handbuilding with Clay

Open to handbuilders at all skill levels, this 10-class session will focus on three basic handbuilding techniques – coiling/pinching, slab building, and extruding. Participants will make vessels and decorative wares with coil and pinch pots for two classes, hard and soft slabs for four classes, and finally extruded forms for two classes. The last two classes will be dedicated to finishing and glazing the ware.

Participants will learn to make a variety of vessels using these different techniques and can expect to be inspired to look around them, both for design ideas, and for tools that will be used in their work, bringing life into clay using only one's hands and ingenuity.

The session meets at our studio located in the heart of historic Georgetown. The fee for a 10-class session is \$400. Cost of clay, use of tools and equipment, glazes and firing are included in the fee, except that large pieces (8+ inches) are subject to glaze-firing surcharges.

Class size is limited to a maximum of 10 students. Hinckley Pottery reserves the right to cancel the session if enrollment does not reach a minimum of five.
